REGULAR MEETING OF .AERO SPONSOR

MEETING MINUTES [07.06]

07 JUNE 2007

A meeting of .aero Sponsor, SITA, was held on 07 June 2007 in Geneva. The following representatives of the Sponsor were present: Fabiano Chies, Marie Zitkova. The meeting was held imminently following the 10th official meeting with the industry advisory body, the Dot Aero Council.

1) DAC membership

- a) Noted that Mr. Gary Cooper became the new ARINC representative with DAC.

2) .aero domain name registrations and registrars

- a) Noted that there has been an increasing number of domain name registrations and new customers.
- b) Noted that two of the .aero registrars – Namesbeyond and Secura have successfully undertaken targeted marketing campaigns and press releases.
- c) Noted that an African registrar Kheweul.Com has expressed interest in becoming a .aero registrar and if they become authorized, they will be the first ever African registrar, authorized by ICANN.

3) Renewal of .aero agreement with ICANN

- a) Noted that the renewal negotiation of the ICANN agreement has not been completed yet and expressed concerns regarding the newly proposed template including the continued requirement to use only ICANN-accredited registrars.
- b) Noted that SITA and other sponsors managed to get back the delegation of the policy development rights but other provisions in the agreement still weaken the delegation.
- c) Agreed SITA to SITA to contact DAC members for verification whether their organization may be listed in new .aero agreement as a party which should be consulted by ICANN in the event of re-delegation of .aero.
- d) Agreed SITA to provide DAC members with updates on the current status of the ICANN negotiations

4) Next steps regarding the reservation of 3 character codes

- a) Noted there was still continuous interest and requests for 3 character names by non airports.
- b) Noted that the significant awareness campaigns to the airport community, to notify them about the possibility to register their 3-letter airport codes, did not raise the expected interest.
- c) Agreed to be set up a process for the release of the codes over a period of 12-18 months, giving the airports community an additional opportunity to register them.
- d) Agreed SITA to draft an action plan for releasing the 3-letter airport codes and circulate it between DAC members before implementing it.

- e) Decided 3-letter codes to be released from reservation after a period, during which airports will be given a last chance to react.

5) Registration of reserved domain name "AGENDA.AERO"

- a) Noted that the registration of this domain name by the interested registrant would have no global impact on the aviation community.
- b) Noted that the domain name has been reserved as a functional domain name.
- c) Agreed SITA to circulate to DAC members the full list of reserved special industry domain names with a view of releasing them unless specific reason for reservation remains.
- d) Decided DAC to review the list of currently reserved special industry domain names and express their view on which ones should be kept reserved.
